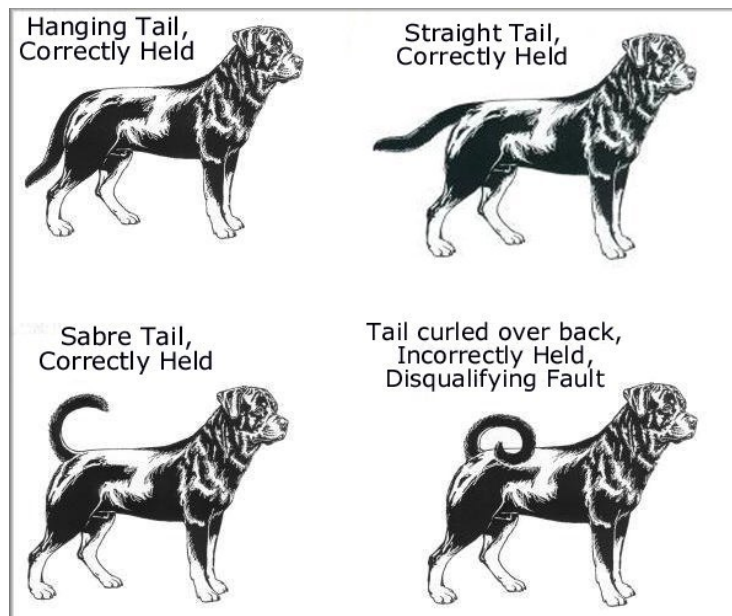


# FCI /ADRK ROTTWEILER TAIL STANDARD

The FCI Standard for the Rottweiler Tail states that in the natural condition the tail should be level in extension of the upper line and may be hanging if at ease.

Faults for the tail include having the tail set on too high or too low.

Eliminating faults for the tail are any tail with a kink, ring tail, or any strong lateral deviation.
